Windy Ridge Guided Tour – Cost 185 Dollars – With Motel Room, – 135 Without Room

The Windy Ridge bus tour will include a level 1 mile Old-growth forest hike and a 2 mile roundtrip hike to Spirit Lake where you may observe the floating log mat (600 ft elevation). Your guide will be answering questions throughout the tour route with a final presentation at Windy Ridge overlook. The two hikes are fairly short with one vertical decent to Spirit Lake with a rise on the return route.

Johnston Ridge Guided Tour – Cost 185 Dollars – With Motel Room, – 135 Without Room

The Johnston Ridge Hike is approximately ten miles in the “Blast Zone.” It will start fairly easy with a long decent to Spirit Lake. The second leg is aggressive traveling south toward the crater. The third leg is a long fairly horizontal traverse west and the final leg is an ascent to the parking lot. You may want to exercise at home, take some smaller hikes and get in shape for this ten-mile hike.
